



Greenhouse Plant Hanger Instructions

COMMON USES


These plant hangers can be used to hang plants, tools, etc. from the greenhouse frame as well as securing shade fabric and bubble insulation to the interior of the greenhouse frame.

REQUIREMENTS

The greenhouse must have an aluminum frame with a center channel designed for mounting hardware to be inserted into it.

INSTALLATION

To install the plant hanger, simply insert the fastener end into the frame channel. Then turn hanger clockwise to lock into place. These plant hangers are universal, however channel / frame thicknesses do vary from one manufacturer to another. Below are helpful tips if the hanger fit is too loose or tight.



Loose Hangers:

If the plant hangers do not fit snugly enough into the frame channel, they will be more likely to slide down the channel when weight is added to them. You can fix this by placing a small piece of plastic or other fabric in between the frame and plant hanger when inserting it into the channel as shown in the picture to the right. Try folding the material or using a thicker material if the fit is still not as snug as desired.



Tight Hangers:

If you have difficulty twisting the plant hanger in the channel, try inserting a screwdriver into the hanger's opening and turning the hanger until it is locked in place. This can happen when fastening bubble or shade to the greenhouse frame.
